WINE MAKERS COMMENT'S

The rich purple hues upon pouring this wine are very striking. The nose is complex that starts off with cigar box, cassis, and underbrush. It has an alluring hint of eucalyptus and dust. The palate is dense with dark cherries and lends to a great concentrated elegance due to the low yielding 2008 vintage. A great Cabernet indicative of the round spice and juniper berry qualities known from the Mayacamas Range.
